Paulína Stachová works from the year 2014 as an Associate Professor at the Faculty of Management Comenius University in Bratislava (before she worked at the faculty as a Lecturer). In her pedagogical work, she is focused on macroeconomics, international economics and international economic relations. She has already supervised a lot of final bachelor and master theses, as well as one dissertation thesis.

In her scientific work she is oriented on the labour market (especially development of the Slovak labour market) and international economic relations (e.g. the impacts of the foreign direct investment on economy, migration within the EU, development assistance), but in the recent time also sustainable growth. For her course International economic relations, in cooperation with her colleague she wrote a textbook with the same name (already published in 2 editions). Within her publications, the domestic, as well as foreign conferences are present.
