NOKIA Award Rules for the Best IBS Students

Article 1

Purpose

- 1. This document establishes the rules and general principles for awarding prizes to the best students enrolled in courses offered by the Iscte Business School (IBS).
- 2. The prizes are intended for the top students completing the following courses in the **2024/2025** academic year:

1st Semester

- a) 00251 Corporate Finance
- b) M8492 Advanced Financial Accounting
- c) M8136 Corporate Financial Strategy (2c) (MSc in Management)

2nd Semester

- d) 04277 International Financial Reporting and Analysis
- e) 04278 Management Control for Value Creation
- f) 04280 Data Analytics for Accounting

Article 2

Number and Value of Prizes

- 1. Six prizes will be awarded in the **2024/2025** academic year.
- 2. Each prize is worth 500,00 € (five hundred euros).
- 3. The prizes for top students are granted by IBS, with sponsorship from NOKIA, SA, as a partner of the school.

Article 3

Eligibility Criteria

- 1. To be recognized as a top student in one of the listed courses, students must meet these criteria:
 - a) Be enrolled in the course for the first time;

- b) Be full-time students at Iscte;
- c) Meet continuous assessment requirements.
- 2. The following students are not eligible for prizes:
 - a) Students who repeat the course;
 - b) Students who have received equivalence to the course unit (for example, exchange students);
 - c) Students who have taken the grade improvement exam.

Article 4

Tiebreakers

- 1. In cases where more than one student achieves the same final eligible grade, the following tiebreakers apply:
 - 1.a. Rankings of individual assessment components in this order:
 - i. Final test;
 - ii. Other individual work (if applicable);
 - 1.b. An oral examination conducted by the course coordinator.

Article 5

Selection Process

- 1. Administrative tasks necessary to identify and confirm eligible students are managed by the IBS Director, in collaboration with the Academic Services.
- 2. The IBS Director appoints a Ranking Committee of three members responsible for verifying eligibility requirements and ranking students.

Article 6

Publication

- 1. The list of award-winning students will be published on the IBS website.
- 2. Any appeals against the list must be submitted within two working days of its publication.
- 3. After this period, award-winning students will be notified by email.

Article 7

Prize Distribution

Prizes are presented at a public session, either in person or online, organized by IBS.

Article 8

Payment

- 1. Prizes are paid at the ISCTE treasury via cheque or bank transfer.
- 2. To receive the prize, the winning student must settle any outstanding debts with ISCTE.

Article 9

Final Provisions

Any interpretive questions or omitted cases in this document will be resolved by order of the IBS Director.
